

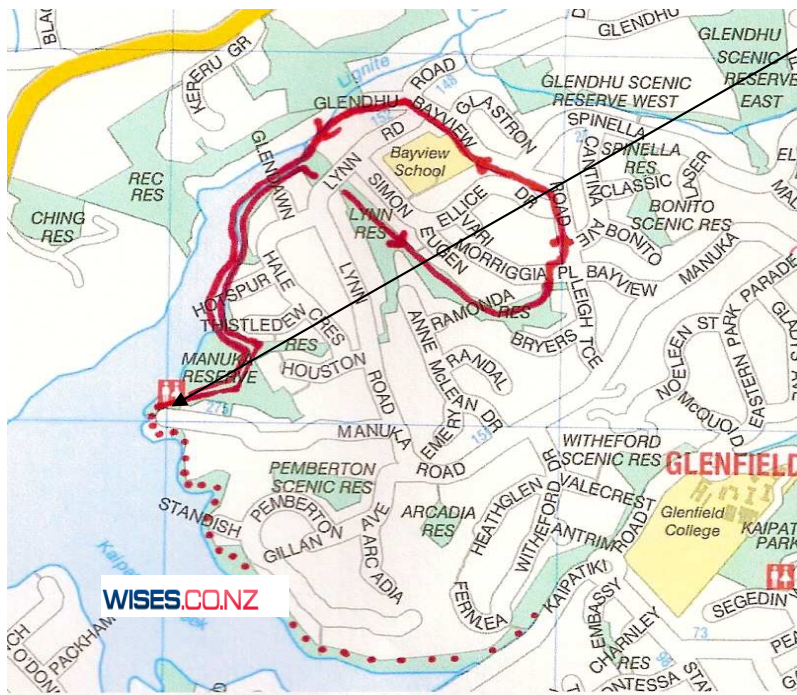
GLENFIELD - COAST + BUSH

As at Oct 09

An easy to moderate walk taking in one of our newest coastal walkways, some little known bush reserves, playgrounds and grassy open spaces.

Start from **MANUKA RESERVE** at the bottom of **MANUKA RD** (toilets and ample parking available).

Allow about an hour, 6000 steps, approx 5Km



START !! From the bottom of **Manuka Rd** face **Manuka Reserve** and walk diagonally across the grassy area to the top right hand corner to access a track down to a bridge and through to a large grassy area. Walk up the middle of this area and at the top veer slightly right then stop and get your bearings. [this is the end of one section of the **coastal walkway** and you will be returning to it later].

!! Two tracks lead off from this area and you need the left hand one which should be labelled to **Hotspur, Hale and Thistledew**

!! Follow this track through the bush and down some steps then **turn sharply left BEFORE the bridge** to access the track to **Hotspur and Lynn Reserve**.

Follow this track through the bush until you reach **Lynn Reserve**. Turn right into the reserve, cross **Lynn Rd** into the main part of the reserve

!! Walk across the reserve to access the bush by a track at the top right hand corner of the grassy area. This well formed track follows up through **Lynn Reserve** and eventually into **Leigh Scenic Reserve** [no signposts at time of writing].

!! Turn left at the first major intersection and follow up by a stand of kauri trees to eventually exit into **Murrigga Place**.

Turn right and walk along to **Bay View Rd** then turn left and walk all the way down **Bay View Rd** to access the **Glenfield Coastal Walkway**.

Turn left into the walkway and follow this track all the way back to once more exit into **Manuka Reserve** at the track convergence noted earlier then retrace your steps back to the start.

[Note: the Glenfield Coastal Walkway continues from across the end of Manuka Rd right round to Kaipatiki Rd but was under repair at time of writing]
