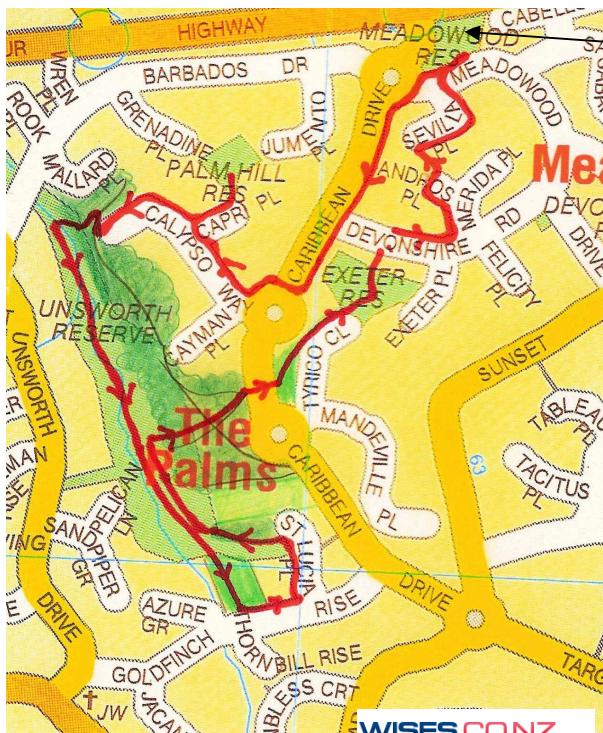


MEADOWOOD AND UNSWORTH RESERVE

[As at Jan 09]

An easy walk through a number of new reserves and tracks. Mainly footpaths and well graded bush tracks. Park near MEADOWOOD COMMUNITY HOUSE. No public toilets available as yet.

Allow about an hour, 6000 steps approx 5Kms.



START From **MEADOWOOD COMMUNITY HOUSE**, walk along to the roundabout and turn left up **CARIBBEAN DR** and cross over. !! At the next roundabout turn right into **CALYPSO WAY** and continue to the right.

Turn right into **CAPRI PL** and just past **no 4** turn left into **PALM HILL RESERVE** and walk up to the palm tree and check out the view.

!! Retrace your steps back to **CAPRI PL** and turn right into **CALYPSO WAY** once more and walk to the end and into the walkway between **no's 36 + 61** (Yes that's right!).

!! In the bush take the track to the left and follow round a considerable distance to the next track junction.

!! Keep on the path to the right and continue down and across a bridge to exit the bush and meet a concrete path.

!! Turn left up this path and follow it all the way up through the reserve and out to **GOLDFINCH RISE**.

Turn left into **GOLDFINCH RISE** and walk along to **ST LUCIA PL**. Turn left again and just past **no 12 ST LUCIA** turn left into **UNSWORTH RESERVE** once more and walk along the landscaped pathway back into the reserve.

Just past the playground turn right and walk back through the middle of the reserve and turn right at the next pathway into the bush. Follow this track back out to **CARIBBEAN DR**.

!! Cross over and pick up the track through a grassy area and on into the bush. Keep left at the first track intersection, and at the next intersection turn left across the bridge and round to exit into **DEVONSHIRE RD**.

Turn right up **DEVONSHIRE RD** then left into **MERIDA PL**.

!! Continue down into **ANDROS PL** and into the walkway by **no 6** to exit into **SEVILLA PL** and back to the start.
