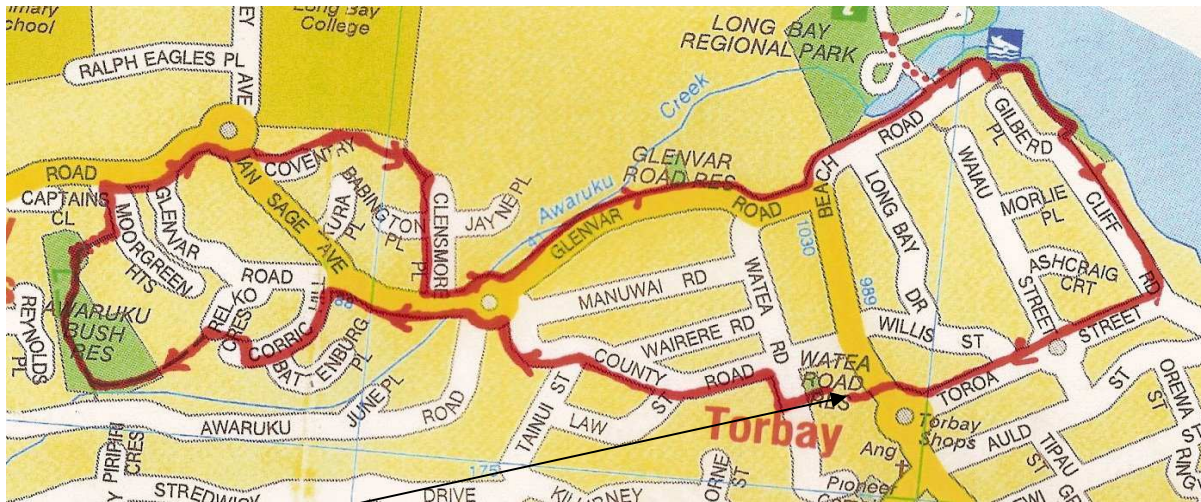


A bush reserve, a coastal Regional Park and a clifftop walkway with spectacular views all contribute to the variety of this moderate to strenuous walk [note that the **AWARUKU BUSH** section has bush tracks and a significant bush staircase]. This walk can easily be cut short should weather or other conditions require or can be extended to include Long Bay Regional Park.

Start **TORBAY COMMUNITY CENTRE** – toilets & ample parking are close by. Allow about 1 ½ hrs, 9,000 steps, 8KM.

START From the **Torbay Community Centre** walk down the drive by the **Senior Citizen's Centre** and turn right into **Watea Rd**, left into **County Rd** and walk all the way down to the roundabout at **Glenvar Rd**.

!! At the roundabout cross to the left into **Glenvar Rd** (Ian Sage Ave) and walk up to **Corric Hill**. Turn left and walk to the end of the street and into the short walkway beside **no 33**. Exit into the end of **Relko Cres** and veer left into the walkway between **17/19** and down into **Awaruku Reserve**.

Follow the track down to the triangular clearing [path to left leads to main entrance of reserve from the **Awaruku Rd**]. !! Take the track to the right and follow the stream to a couple of clearings in the old quarry.

!! From this point on there a number of tracks leading back down the valley but you need to choose tracks going up and to the right to eventually reach a major set of steps leading up to **Moorgreen Heights**.

At the top turn left into **Moorgreen Heights** and walk along to **Glenvar Rd**

!! Turn right, cross over and walk down to the roundabout. Turn right into **Ian Sage Ave** then turn left into **Coventry Way**. !! Continue on into the extension **32/23** and near the end turn right into the walkway **44/46**. At the walkway T-intersection turn right and follow the path down to **Clensmore Pl** Turn right and walk down to **Glenvar Rd** and turn left. Continue down **Glenvar Rd** into **Beach Rd** and down to **Long Bay**.

** Explore **Long Bay Regional Park** if desired**.

!! To return go to the end of **Beach Rd** to pick up the **Oneroa Track** which is just to the right of the very last building (**MERC**). Continue on this clifftop walkway to eventually come out at **Gilberd Pl**.

Turn left into **Cliff Rd** and walk up to **Toroa St**. Turn right into **Toroa St** and walk all the way back to the roundabout at **Beach Rd** and back to the starting point.
