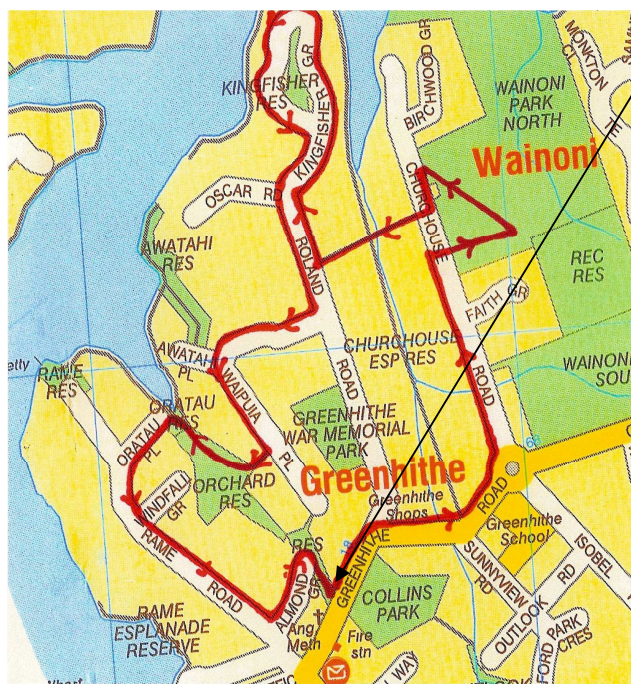


GREENHITHE

[As at Jan 09]

For peace and tranquility this easy walk with its beautiful gardens and interesting reserves is hard to beat. Nearly all of this walk is on level footpaths and easily negotiated, well formed tracks.

START at the store in **GREENHITHE RD**. Ample parking nearby, Public toilets are at **WAINONI PARK** but are not always open. Allow about 1+1/4 hours and 6000 steps/5KM

START !! Facing the **store** walk right along **Greenhithe Rd**, cross **Roland Rd** and continue on **Greenhithe Rd** past the school and then turn left into **Churchouse Rd**.

!! Continue down past **Faith Grove** then immediately past **no 50** turn right through the fancy gates into the walkway alongside the driveway into **Wainoni Park**.

When level with the **Soccer Pavilion (concrete block building on left and which may have toilets available)** turn left off the walkway and cross the parking area to the left of the pavilion. From here cross the playing fields diagonally to the left on past the playground and exit again into **Churchouse Rd**.

Walk left back up the road before crossing over to enter the walkway between **no's 53 + 51**. !! This track leads in to the pumping station and continues down to the right, across the stream, through a paddock and eventually exits into **Roland Rd**.

Turn right and walk down to **Kingfisher Grove**. Staying on the right hand side continue right round the grove back to **Roland Rd** and continue up to **Waipua Pl** !! Turn right here and right again into the walkway between **no's 65 and 67** and follow the track into **Oratau Reserve**.

Cross the bridge and continue on the track to the second upwards exit where the track forks. !!! Take the upper track to the left [the lower track continues through the bush and alongside the stream for another 10 mins or so. **At dead low tide it is possible to negotiate the mud and rocks to eventually exit at the boat ramp at the end of Rame Rd. At time of writing (Jan 07) there was no land based exit available**]. And exit into **Oratau Place**.

Walk up to **Rame Rd** turn left and continue up to **Almond Pl**.

!! Walk to the grassy reserve at the end of **Almond Pl** then turn right to link up with the track back to the start.
