HARBOUR SPORT SPORTS SUMMIT SUMMARY

The Sport Summit was held on June 8 with a purpose of Sport engagement in Council and Local Board process planning.

The summit was the first opportunity after the change in structure of Auckland governance to discuss how we as Sport Leaders and Community Leaders determine new ways of working together.

The goal was to discuss ways to benefit Sport and Recreation in our region. Attendees included key sport leaders in the community, Auckland Councillors from the North Harbour Region, Local Board Chairs and Board members, Auckland Council Sport and Recreation officers, Harbour Sport Board Members and Harbour Sport Staff.

Issues in the region were discussed, with a focus toward finding what's best for sport. Types of issues included, the way in which sub regional and regional planning occurs for sport under the new co-governance structure. What methods of communication would be best to ensure all parties receive and forward quality information? What management process should be put in place to make decisions for the region regarding sport and recreation? Toni-Maree Carnie, CEO of Harbour Sport said *It isn't beneficial to have Sports and Boards having to present a number of times to each other when there are critical issues that affect the whole of the sub region or several Sports.*

The meeting proved to be positive for all parties involved. All agreed to contribute further to developing a model where each party can collaborate on solving sporting issues.

The North Harbour region has always prided itself in being at the front of the pack. This forum and the process which will evolve is a further opportunity to demonstrate that sport is important in our community.

Key community leaders see the importance and value of sport. Sport provides significant health and well being outcomes as well as social cohesiveness, social capital and economic benefits. New Zealanders love to play sport as it great fun. Our role is to ensure we all can.

CHINESE SPORT FORUM



Harbour Sport's ActivAsian team will hold the second Chinese Sport Forum on **Thursday 11th August 2011**. The first Chinese Sport Forum was organised with the main objectives of:

- Establish an on-going two-way dialogue between the Chinese community and RSO's on the North Shore of Auckland
- Create an opportunity for members of the Chinese community to voice their barriers and needs regarding sports and for sports to outline what they are able to deliver
- Increase cultural understanding and awareness
- Help sports understand the need to engage with a growing population in the community



The first Chinese Sport Forum saw over 100 attendees, more than 65 of which were members of the Chinese community and 35 from sport and other aligned organisations. Since then we have been working closely with several sports including Squash, Netball, Rhythmic Gymnastics, Tennis, Petanque, Badminton and Golf in

implementing the Asian Sport Engagement Model and improving access to information for the Chinese community on the North Shore.

We are hopeful that with on-going communication between the ethnic communities and sports, we will be able to see great outcomes in Asian sport participation.

On the 20th and 21st of June the Activate conference was held for secondary school sports coordinators, administrators and

PE staff. The aim of the conference was to provide a professional development opportunity for those people involved in Secondary School sport from across the upper North Island (Bay of Plenty up to Northland). Delegates left the conference with plenty of inspiration and ideas to improve the delivery of sport within their schools.

One of the workshops at the conference was led by 4 national sporting bodies. Hockey NZ, Netball NZ, NZ Rugby League and Bike NZ. The purpose of the presentation was to provide secondary schools with an outline of how each sport is working in the secondary school sector and their plans for future development of the sport. Delegates found the session to be a valuable one in which they were able to gain a clear idea of how each sport plans to operate and opportunities available for their students.
