

How do I enter the run?

There are two ways to enter the 2010 Youthtown Shore to Shore 5km Fun Run/Walk. You may register through your local primary school or register on the day at the Late registrations table. (Please note that late registrations are \$15)

How much does it cost to enter?

The entry fee is \$7 if entered through your local primary school. \$15 for on the day entries.

Do I have to pay in order to compete?

Yes, every person taking part in the event must pay the entry fee.

Do entries sell-out?

No, there is no limit to the number of participants for the 2010 Youthtown Shore to Shore 5km Fun Run/Walk.

Can I get a refund on my entry?

No, entry fees are not refundable.

What should I do if I lose my race number?

Email the organisers prior to the event. On the day go to the Late registrations table and you will receive a replacement race number.

What other rules are there?

DECLARATION: We enter and intend competing entirely at our own risk. We give our consent for the information on this form to be collected by Harbour Sport for the purpose of administration and marketing, as well as any photos we appear in. We also acknowledge our right to access and correct this information. This consent is given in accordance with the Privacy Act 1993.

The Start**What time should I be at the Start?**

We suggest arriving no later than 8.30am so you have time to collect race numbers, go to the toilet and hear important race instructions from our MC. Race starts at 9am.

Where is the Start line?

The Start line is on the bottom Rugby field at Takapuna Grammar School. Off Winscombe Road.

Is there parking at Takapuna Grammar?

No, you will have to park on local side streets. There will be no parking along Lake Road. We suggest catching one of the buses.

Are their toilets?

Yes. There are limited portaloo toilets.

Which roads will be closed for public access?

No roads are closed. There is a partial closure on Lake Road.

Where can I register if I haven't done so through my local school?

Late Registration desk which will be located on the bottom field. Late Registrations will be \$15 per person.

During the Run**Can I rollerblade or cycle?**

No, rollerblades and bicycles are not permitted on the course.

Can I bring my dog?

No, animals are not permitted on the course.

Can I push my child in a pram?

Yes, prams are permitted. We recommend entrants with prams start toward the back of the pack and keep to the left of the course.

Can my child take a bike or a scooter?

No, for safety reasons bikes, scooters and rollerblades are not permitted on the course.

Is it Wheelchair accessible?

Yes. Ramps are provided at beach access points.

The Finish**Is there parking at Milford?**

Yes, you may park at Milford Mall.

What happens at the Finish?

Runners arriving at the Finish will be directed through the gantry up onto Milford Reserve. Prize giving will take place after the last runner/walker is though (normally around 10.45am).

Who is the MC?

Sam Wallace from Sticky TV will be hosting the finish line festivities, along with someone from Classic Hits 97.4FM.

Can I bring my BBQ and pitch a tent?

Schools are permitted to book sites through Harbour Sport for post race celebrations/BBQs.

Where do I go at the finish venue if I need help?

There will be a first aid/Information tent at the finish line. Located to the right of the stage.

Medical

Order of St John ambulances will be located at the end of the race. In the event of a medical emergency, dial 111 from the nearest phone and the closest ambulance will be sent to your aid.

If you have a medical condition that could cause you difficulties during or after the race, please first get clearance from your doctor to participate in your event.

Buses

Is there parking at Milford Mall?

Yes, you may park at Milford Mall

Are there Pre-race buses from Milford to Takapuna Grammar?

Yes. Morning buses leave Milford Mall carpark for Takapuna Grammar at 7.15am with the last bus leaving the mall at 7.45am.

Tokens **MUST BE** pre-purchased from your local primary school to ride this bus.

Tokens are \$3 per person per way.

Are there Post-race buses from Milford to Takapuna Grammar?

Yes. Buses after the race depart Milford Mall carpark at 11.30am with the last one leaving at 12pm.

Tokens **MUST BE** pre-purchased from your local primary school to ride this bus.

Tokens are \$3 per person per way.

Are the Buses Free?

No. Tokens **MUST BE** pre-purchased from your local primary school to ride this bus.

Tokens are \$3 per person per way.

Are they Wheelchair accessible?

Yes, the last two buses on rotation will be wheelchair accessible.

So, roughly 7.30am and 7.45am and 12pm and 12.15pm leaving Milford for Takapuna
